## **Dear Corbett Prep Families,**

Our founders, Marilyn Gatlin and Betty Anderson, believed in choice; Some 50 years later, our dress code embraces that belief by offering a variety of options for our students and allows them to express themselves within the boundaries of color, style and fabric.

Adhering to the Corbett Prep dress code prepares students for real life work expectations. The current criteria are designed to promote a positive self-image for the student and maintain proper decorum for a learning environment. All items should be clean, in good repair, represent modest dress, present a neat appearance, and be totally appropriate for a school setting.

## Dress code choices for MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY are as follows:

## The options for shirts and sweatshirts available in many colors, include the following:

- 1. T-shirts with Corbett Prep logo (center or side logo)
- 2. Polo shirts with Corbett Prep logo (side logo only)
- 3. Solid and camo moisture-wicking shirts with Corbett Prep logo (center or side logo)
- 4. Tie-dye t-shirts with Corbett Prep logo (center or side logo)
- 5. Polo shirt dresses with Corbett Prep logo (side logo only)
- 6. Moisture-Wicking polos with Corbett Prep logo (side logo only)
- 7. Long-sleeved t-shirts and moisture-wicking shirts with Corbett Prep logo (center or side logo)
- 8. Hooded full-zip sweatshirt (side logo only) and pullover hooded sweatshirts (center or side logo)

## **DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS:**

- Monday through Thursday is a choice from options 1 through 8 listed above.
- Corbett Prep event t-shirts are great for Fridays, such as Musical Theatre shirts, camp shirts, etc. Tops that have positive images / words are also acceptable.
- Shirts for both boys and girls are to be a length that can easily be tucked in (when arms are raised, midriff will remain covered).
- Monday through Friday choices for <u>bottoms:</u> These may be purchased where you like to shop. Shorts, pants, skorts, and skirts must be **a solid color**, and must be in good condition and school appropriate. Pajama-type pants, yoga pants, leggings, or pants with rips, holes, or tears are non-examples. <u>Tight fitting pants are great options for after-school and weekends.</u>
- Please note that all bottoms must be **3 inches above the knee or longer**.
- Field trips, special events, and performances **REQUIRE** a green Corbett Prep polo shirt and pants that are khaki, black, or navy.
- Middle School students will be **REQUIRED** to dress in the Corbett Prep Physical Education clothes for all PE classes starting in <u>JANUARY 2021</u>. Locker rooms are temporarily closed. (See page 4 for PE shirt and shorts)
- PK3 and PK4 students carry a green Corbett Prep tote, in lieu of a traditional backpack.
- Shoes must be closed-toed for safety at play and healthy outdoor activities. Athletic shoes (often called sneakers) are preferred daily and are **REQUIRED** for PE and intramural classes.
